### **Acute Myeloid Leukemia AML**

There are 8 types of AML-M0 to M7. You may hear your doctor talk about some of these types.

- M0, M1 and M2 are all myeloblastic leukemia. Most people with AML have one of these types.
- M3 is acute promyelocytic leukemia (APL). About 1 in 10 adult AML patients has the APL type. (Stephanie Haskins had this one.)
- M4 is acute myelomonocytic leukemia. About 1 in 5 AML patients has this type.
- M5 is acute monocytic leukemia. About 15 out of 100 AML patients have this type.
- M6 is acute erythroleukemia and M7 is acute megakaryocytic leukemia. These types are rare.
